### **Afternoon Party Trains (PM) 2018**

The party coach is reserved for your exclusive use, but members of the public will be travelling on the other coach.

You may bring your own food and refreshments onto the train, a large table is provided, but we cannot permit alcohol onto the site without prior permission. We can keep your food cool if required. We can also arrange for Megabites of Rothwell to provide food for your party at a cost of approximately £5.00 per head.

This train service is a public service and is advertised to run at these specific times and every effort will be made to adhere to the timetable. Please be aware of this!!

Your first train will leave Moor Road station at 14:00 prompt and travel to Park Halt. It will remain there for a few minutes whilst the locomotive is run around the coaches and the train will then return to Moor Road. The whole return journey takes approximately 25 minutes. Once back at Moor Road the train will prepare to leave again at 14:40, your last departure will be at 15:20.

You may either stay on the train or spend some time at Park Halt and Middleton Woods/Park, or a combination of both. Please inform the Guard of your intentions and he will lock your coach if needed. Whilst at the Railway, and on the train, you are responsible for all the children in your party, please ensure they are supervised at all times. Every endeavour is made to ensure your enjoyment and safety whilst at the Railway, but we do require your cooperation and assistance in this matter. If in doubt please ask a member of staff for guidance.

You are advised to arrive at Moor Road with your guests no later than 13:45, to give you time to board the train. Your last train leaves Moor Road at 15:20 and will return to Moor Road at approximately 15:45. Your last train from Park Halt is 15:35.

All toilet facilities are at Moor Road, there are no toilet facilities on the train, or at Park Halt.

The Guard is your point of contact on the train. A first aid kit is carried on the train together with a fire extinguisher.

Should you wish to contact the Duty Manager during your visit, he can be located on 0113 271 0320.

Please be aware of the maximum number of people on the Party Coach is 36 persons. Additional guests may travel on the normal coach and we will give them a 10% discount on standard fares. Children under 12 months are not counted.

We regret that the shop and cafe area cannot be used for either eating and/or for the playing of games. Please be aware that all the Railway's buildings, platforms and rolling stock are "No Smoking Areas".
